### Psalm 119:140-154 ESV

(140) Your promise is well tried, and your servant loves it.  
(141) I am small and despised, yet I do not forget your precepts.  
(142) Your righteousness is righteous forever, and your law is true.  
(143) Trouble and anguish have found me out, but your commandments are my delight. (144) Your testimonies are righteous forever; give me understanding that I may live. (145) With my whole heart I cry; answer me, O LORD! I will keep your statutes.  
(146) I call to you; save me, that I may observe your testimonies.  
(147) I rise before dawn and cry for help; I hope in your words.  
(148) My eyes are awake before the watches of the night, that I may meditate on your promise. (149) Hear my voice according to your steadfast love; O LORD, according to your justice give me life. (150) They draw near who persecute me with evil purpose; they are far from your law. (151) But you are near, O LORD, and all your commandments are true. (152) Long have I known from your testimonies that you have founded them forever. (153) Look on my affliction and deliver me, for I do not forget your law. (154) Plead my cause and redeem me; give me life according to your promise!

#### A. The source of our promises

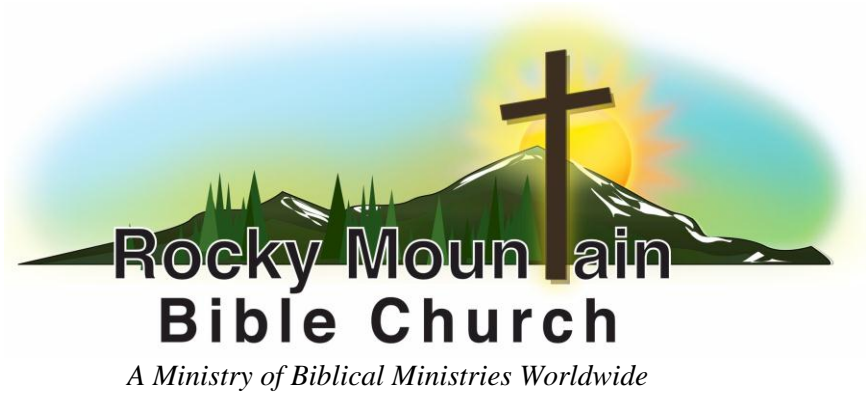
1. The source is Jesus Christ Himself

  - Through receiving a new nature Colossians 3:10; Ephesians 4:24
  - Through the presence of the indwelling Holy Spirit 1 Corinthians 3:16; 6:19
- How we do not become partakers of the divine nature. 1 Corinthians 11:26; Ephesians 2:8-9
